Grade 3 and 5 NAPLAN TESTING TIMETABLE FOR 2019

The first week of NAPLAN testing has now been completed. This week the focus was mainly on completing the testing for Grade 5 students. Next week Grade 3s will complete their testing.

As has been reported previously, this year, NAPLAN testing for all Australian students, other than the Grade 3 writing task, is conducted online. Although Grade 3 writing was done using pencil and paper on Tuesday.

In recognition of the need to ensure all students have access to suitable devices, we are able to conduct the testing over two weeks, provided we complete both the Grade 3 and Grade 5 writing task within the first two days of the testing period.

Accordingly, the remainder of our testing timetable is shown below. This week it would be greatly appreciated if parents could support their Grade 3 children by ensuring they get a good night's sleep before their testing days.
