#### ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT SUPPORT

Recently, Grade 6 students from our school undertook an education tour of the national capital. Students were given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. This included visiting Parliament House, the War Memorial, the Australian Electoral Commission, and the Museum of Australian Democracy.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government contributed funding of \$200 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs.

The rebate will be paid directly to our school now that we have completed the excursion, as the \$200 has already been deducted from the total cost that parents would otherwise have had to pay.
